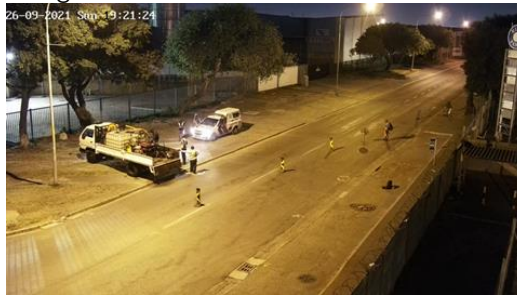

UPDATE ON NUMSA STRIKE ACTION:

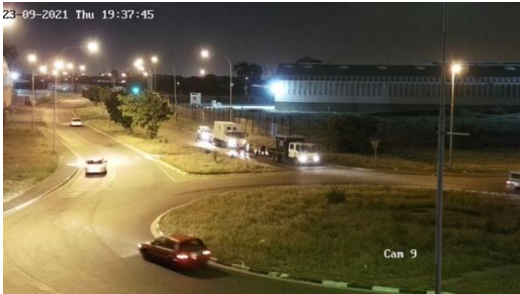
Please note that the CID is monitoring the strikers daily by means of camera as well as our vehicles. Should any incidents occur the necessary authorities will be requested, who I have already liaised with and are on "standby" should their presence be required.

RESURFACING OF ROADS IN PAROW INDUSTRIA:

Kindly note that the COCT has already commenced with the resurfacing of Industria Ring Road on 2021-09-22. The section from Stoker Road to Assegaai Road is being done.



A section of Radnor Road will also be done before Robert Sobukwe Robots.



All street markings will also be repainted as part of this project.

It has been indicated that Junction Road will be resurfaced next year. In the interim patching jobs are being done with long pieces being repaired instead of only the immediate area around the pothole which does not withstand the first rains thereafter.

BROKEN DRAINS:

Please note that drains are being repaired in the area and within weeks are damaged again by trucks and or employees parking on the pavements.

One of the drains which was finally repaired in Junction Road after months of correspondence and follow ups by the CID, and even having to escalate to Sub-council, was broken within weeks due to vehicles driving over it.

Employees are kindly to be cautioned not to park on pavements over drain covers. Kindly also ensure your truck drivers are cautioned to be vigilant of drain covers and bollards.

Below is an example of the re-occurring drains that are being damaged in Parow Industria, this one on the corner of Radnor & Stellenberg Road:

- Drain damaged for a second time on 17 March 2021
- Repairs began 7 April and were completed in June.ay
- Damaged again August 2021 (still awaiting repairs for the THIRD time)

CID CRIME STATISTICS* FOR SEPTEMBER 2021:

	SEPTEMBER 2021
Friday, 3 September 2021, at approx. 02:00am	<p>Robbery of cellphone in Radnor Road: No case was made</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 01:59am, the CID Control Room spotted 1 x male running from the petrol station in Radnor Road towards De La Rey Robots. • Romeo 2 was dispatched and arrived at the petrol station at 02:02am and spoke to one of the petrol attendants who confirmed that while his colleague was busy with a client, 1 x male got out of an unknown truck and entered the wooden guard house and grabbed his cell phone and ran away towards the robots. The truck followed shortly behind the suspect. • The CID Control Room contacted Ravensmead SAPS who confirmed that a vehicle would be dispatched. • A playback was done on the CID's camera monitoring system and the Controllers noticed that a small white truck with 2 x males sitting at the back entered Radnor Road from De La Rey Road and drove straight to the petrol station. Due to the rotation of the camera (programmed pan & tilt) the footage does not show the victim being robbed.
Saturday, 4 September 2021, at approx. 23:30pm	<p>Illegally Leaving Place of Residence during Curfew 22:00pm – 04:00am (Stellenberg Road):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 23:30pm, the CID Control Room spotted 1 x male walking in Stellenberg Road cul-de-sac. • The male refused to turn around and indicated that he was on his way to his brother's house in Ravensmead. • At 23:35pm, the CID Control Room contacted Ravensmead SAPS who confirmed that their vehicle was standing off at an accident scene. • The Responders were instructed by the Controllers to apprehend the suspect and put him at the back of the CID patrol vehicle, however the suspect ran away with his dog and the Responders indicated that they would not be able to catch him. • At 23:46pm, whilst being monitored on camera and by the CID vehicle, the suspect left the area via MC Beukes Street, Ravensmead, and SAPS was cancelled.
Sunday, 5 September 2021, at 00:04am	<p>Illegally Leaving Place of Residence during Curfew 22:00pm – 04:00am (Junction Road) Arrest by CID Responders and taken to Ravensmead Police Station:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 00:04, Romeo 2 reported 1 x male walking in Junction Road who entered the area via the field in Trans Oranje Road. The male reported that he was on his way home from Belhar. • At 00:08am, the CID Control Room contacted Ravensmead SAPS, however they indicated that their vehicle was still standing off at the accident scene of 23:35 and that they would dispatch the vehicle as soon as its available. • After numerous follow ups, the CID Control Room contacted Ravensmead SAPS again at 02:00am who then asked if the CID could bring the suspect to Ravensmead Police Station. • At 02:32am, Romeo 2 was back in the area and confirmed that the suspect was handed over to Ravensmead SAPS. • Suspect is reportedly from Ravensmead.
Tuesday, 14 September 2021, at approx. 16:30pm	<p>Business Robbery (Stellenberg Road) as well as a secondary charge Ravensmead CAS 122/9/2021 & CID footage handed over to Ravensmead SAPS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 18:03pm, SAPS arrived at the CID office wanting to view footage of a business robbery involving a white Quantum that occurred at a shop in Stellenberg Road the same day at approx. 16:30pm. Allegedly the suspects entered the shop, closed the door and proceeded to rob the occupants. The vehicle fled the scene via the Radnor / De La Rey robots. • The CID Control Room did a playback on the CID's camera monitoring system and was able to obtain and hand over the suspect's Vehicle Registration number to SAPS.
Tuesday, 21 September 2021, at approx. 01:30am	<p>Break-in and Theft from Motor Vehicle at business in Stellenberg Road:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 01:32am, the CID Control Room spotted a white bakkie standing in front of a business premises in Stellenberg Road and then reversed into the premises. • At 01:34am, the bakkie moved out of the premises and Romeo 2 was dispatched who stopped them at the bus stop just further up the road. There were 4 x males inside the vehicle. • The driver told Romeo 2 that they went to park the bakkie at the premises but then the manager called them to say he is coming himself. The driver gave his details to the CID Responder and left the area via Radnor Road. • The CID Controllers tried contacting the after-hours emergency contacts but mistakenly called the incorrect company. • At 01:47am, the CID Control Room contacted Ravensmead SAPS who confirmed that the owner of the building must make a case if something was stolen or damaged. The Control Room gave SAPS the vehicle registration number of the suspicious vehicle.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 14:12pm the afternoon, CID Responder Romeo 1 confirmed that the company reported that the suspects broke into one of the vehicles parked on the premises by smashing the rear window. The vehicle belongs to an employee of a neighbouring company who usually parks his bakkie on their premises. The main gate and padlock was also damaged.
Saturday, 25 September 2021, at approx. 04:00am	<p>Rape involving a red Toyota Corolla (Stoker Circle): No case was opened by victim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 04:18am, the CID Responder Romeo 2 reported a red Toyota Corolla at Stoker Circle with 2 x males and 1 x female. Romeo 2 spoke to the female who indicated that the two men tried to rape her. Whilst Romeo 2 was speaking to the female, the vehicle drove off towards Junction Road and out of the area. The victim confirmed that the males picked her up in Bellville and forced her to get inside the vehicle. She indicated that she does not know them, nor does she know where to find them. At 04:21am, Romeo 2 informed the Control Room that the victim refused to wait with him for SAPS and was walking down Junction Road. Romeo 2 was following shortly behind her in his vehicle to ensure her safety. At 04:22am, the CID Control Room contacted Ravensmead SAPS who confirmed that a vehicle would be dispatched. The vehicle registration number of the suspect's vehicle was handed over to SAPS. At 04:41am, SAPS arrived and caught up with the female in Junction Road. At 04:43am, SAPS informed Romeo 2 that they will take the victim to the police station where she will open a case. At 04:44am, SAPS left the area towards De La Rey robots. Footage will be handed over to Ravensmead SAPS for further investigation.
