## **CID CRIME STATISTICS FOR OCTOBER 2021:**

Kindly note that petty crime is on the rise. Kindly ensure that you caution your workers to not walk and talk on cellphones, to "hide" all valuables and to ensure vehicles are properly locked when parking. Please also be aware that persons who appear helpful do not always have your best interests at heart – we had an incident where a person helped to push a stranded vehicle, got himself behind the wheel and when the vehicle started, he drove off leaving the owner behind. The vehicle was found back but was already stripped.

Any suspicious activity is to rather be immediately reported to the CID control room on 021 932 4800 so that a patrol vehicle can be dispatched to monitor any suspicious persons.

| <p>Friday, 1 October 2021, at approx. 16:31</p>          | <p><b>Cell phone robbery: Industria Ring Road:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 16h31, the CID responder reported that while he was on patrol, down Industria Ring Road, he was stopped by 1 x female on the corner of Industria Ring Road and Stoker Road.</li> <li>• The female informed the responder that 1 x male on a bicycle, grabbed her cell phone in front of Coke Peninsula Beverages and fled towards Denton Street.</li> <li>• At 16h32 the CID responder drove towards Denton Street to try and catch up with the suspect.</li> <li>• At 16h33 the CID responder reported that the male was already out of the area.</li> <li>• At 16h36 after the CID control room did an Instant Playback, Ravensmead SAPS was contacted on 021 933 9000, who was informed of the incident since the suspect fled the area. Clothing description and direction was given to them, who said that they will dispatch a vehicle to Ravensmead area to see if they can spot the suspect.</li> <li>• At 16h40 the CID responder informed that the female indicated she will not open a case as she does not have insurance on the phone.</li> </ul> <p>At 16h50 Romeo 1 reported that the victim left the area taking a Taxi in Industria Ring Road.</p>   |
| <p>Sunday, 3 October 2021, at approx. 16:18</p>          | <p><b>Theft of stop street signage: Arrest by CID responders.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 16:18 CID control room saw a Bakkie, coming from Stoker Circle driving slowly down Junction Road towards the C/n of Radnor Road and Trans Karoo Road.</li> <li>• At 16:24 The bakkie stopped and 2 x males got out of the Bakkie, took out the Stop Sign pole and put it into the Bakkie.</li> <li>• At 16:25 both CID patrol vehicles were dispatched due to it being a vehicle and several occupants.</li> <li>• At 16:27 Romeo 2 arrived and caught up with 1 x male in Junction Road, and the other one in Radnor Road and put them in the back of the Romeo1 Bakkie.</li> <li>• At 16:28 the CID control room contacted Ravensmead SAPS and reported the matter, who informed them that a vehicle will be despatched.</li> <li>• At 16:29 The Bakkie left the area towards Robert Sobukwe robots.</li> </ul>  |
| <p>Monday, 4 October 2021, between 20:20 &amp; 20:22</p> | <p><b>Housebreaking ( business premises), Tekstiel street:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The CID was informed on 2021-10-05, that unknown persons with a White Polo motor vehicle had entered the premises at Tekstiel street by forcing the front door. Nothing was stolen as the building was empty.</li> <li>• On perusal of the CID's camera footage, it was ascertained that the vehicle was driving around in the area before the incident, but as there was a lot of traffic in the area, it was not noted as suspicious by the CID controllers or responders. In fact, the CID patrol vehicle rode past the vehicle twice whilst on patrol. The persons were in the premises for approximately, 2 minutes at 20:21, whereafter they quickly fled the area via Robert Sobukwe robots. The vehicle could not be picked up on LPR and it was then ascertained that the vehicle did not have number plates.</li> </ul>  |
| <p>Sunday, 10 October 2021, at approx. 00:41</p>         | <p><b>Illegally Leaving place of residence during Curfew: Industria Ring Road</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 00h41, the CID control room spotted 2 x males in Industria Ring Road walking in the direction of Stoker Road. Romeo 1 responder was immediately dispatched.</li> <li>• At 00h44 the CID responder caught up with the males in Stoker Road.</li> <li>• At 00h50 Romeo1 informed the control room that the males indicated that they came from Elsie's River and are on their way home to Bellville South, and that they almost got robbed on the Corner of De La Rey Road and Fransie Van Zyl Road. They got a change to run away from their attackers before they got to take anything by running between the houses in Fransie Van Zyl Road into Industria Ring Road.</li> <li>• At 00h52 Romeo2 was despatched to stand-off with the males in Stoker Road.</li> <li>• At 00h53 the CID control room contacted Ravensmead SAPS, who indicated that a vehicle will be dispatched. Romeo2 stood off with the males waiting.</li> <li>• At 01h13, the 107 Emergency nr was contacted where the call was logged with SAPS.</li> <li>• At 01h40 Romeo 2 informed the control room that the 2 x males decided to leave the area to walk home and said they will report the incident later (during daylight) to Bellville South SAPS.</li> <li>• At 02h07 Romeo 2 reported the 2 x males left the area via Robert Sobukwe Road and were monitored the whole time they were in the CID area.</li> </ul> |

No one was inside the vehicle.</li> <li>• At 17h28 Ravensmead SAPS was contacted, informed them of the abandoned vehicle and they confirmed that a vehicle will be despatched.</li> <li>• At 18:05 SAPS confirmed the vehicle was hijacked in Bothasig to the CID controllers in the control room.</li> <li>• At 19:46 a SAPS member drives the hijacked vehicle out of the area.</li> </ul>   |

| Monday, 18 October 2021, at approx. 16:03         | <p><b><u>Theft in Radnor Road (Arrest by CID responder)</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At 16:03 CID responder reported to the CID control room that while in Radnor Road on his patrols, he was approached by a manager, informing him about 1 x male who was busy stealing inside the store.</li> <li>At 16:03 CID responder was dispatched immediately to assist Romeo 2.</li> <li>At 16:04 CID responder arrived in Radnor Road and reported that the manager asked them to assist the onsite security as the suspect was fighting with the security to get away.</li> <li>At 16:18 CID responder reported that the suspect allegedly stole goods to the value of R382,00 and also vandalised the shelves of the store during the fight with the security.</li> <li>At 16:19 CID responder confirmed that the Manager of the shop confirmed that the CID can call SAPS as she wants to open a case.</li> <li>At 16:20 Ravensmead SAPS was contacted who confirmed that a SAPS vehicle will be sent.</li> <li>At 16:35 SAPS arrived at the scene.</li> <li>At 17:22 SAPS left the area with the suspect.</li> </ul>   |
| Wednesday, 20 October 2021, between 14:30 & 17:00 | <p><b><u>Theft of truck battery: Corner Parin and Industria Ring Road</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The CID office was informed of the alleged theft of a truck battery which was stolen off a truck.</li> <li>Camera playback was done, and it was ascertained that the vehicle was parked off for the day on the corner of Industria Ring Road and Parin Road, but due to the manner in which it was parked it was impossible to see if/when the battery was stolen.</li> </ul>  |
| Sunday, 23 October 2021, at approx. 22:00         | <p><b><u>Theft of Motor vehicle: Radnor Road:</u></b> Ravensmead CAS 223/10/2021</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At 21:58: CID control room spotted a male and female entering the area at De La Rey robots. The couple were live monitored and when it was seen that they are not going to the shop (which is the only premises open at that time of night), Romeo 1 was immediately dispatched to question them and escort them out of the area.</li> <li>At 22:00:09 it was noted that the male approached a vehicle that had 1 occupant and 3 persons pushing the vehicle in Radnor Road.</li> <li>At 22:00:39 the man who had entered the area was seen getting inside the vehicle whilst the others pushed.</li> <li>At 22:01:18 when the vehicle started, the man drove off with the vehicle to Robert Sobukwe robots, leaving the others who had pushed the vehicle standing in the street.</li> <li>At 22:01:26 CID patroller arrived on the scene and was informed by one of the persons who had pushed the vehicle that the vehicle belongs to him and that the person who had "helped" them, had now stolen his vehicle.</li> <li>At 22:07 Ravensmead SAPS was contacted.</li> <li>At 22:08 Romeo 1 was informed by the control room that the female who had entered the area with the male, now suspected of stealing the vehicle, was still in the area.</li> <li>CID responders, female, and persons whose vehicle had been stolen stood off, awaiting the arrival of SAPS.</li> <li>At 22:22 SAPS arrived and let the lady go as they indicated she is not involved. She left the area towards Uitsig on foot.</li> <li>On 2021-10-26 SAPS confirmed the vehicle had been found and suspect arrested.</li> </ul> |
| Monday, 25 October 2021, at approx. 23:38         | <p><b><u>Theft of steel fencing pipe: cnr Radnor and De La Rey Road:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At 23h38 the CID control room spotted 1 x male pulling at the burglar bar in front of the window of a premises in Radnor Road.</li> <li>At 23h38 both CID vehicles were dispatched.</li> <li>At 23h39 Romeo 1 arrived at De La Rey Robots, but as soon as the suspect saw the CID patrol vehicle, he ran over De La Rey Road towards Uitsig and then started walking.</li> <li>At 23h41 whilst monitoring, the control room saw that the suspect is back on corner Radnor and De La Rey Road and pulled a steel pole from the fence and ran towards Uitsig again. Both responders were immediately dispatched.</li> <li>At 23h45 CID responder informed the control room that the window was open.</li> <li>The Client was contacted and the CID patrollers were requested to do regular patrols.</li> <li>SAPS was informed of the incident and that the suspect had ran into Uitsig. Clothing description of the suspect was given.</li> <li>• At 10h35 the CID control room contacted SAPS, informing that the suspect escaped to Uitsig, but gave his clothing description.
