You will notice some familiar faces on the street still, and this is due to the fact that Byers has taken over certain staff on a 3 month probation period.

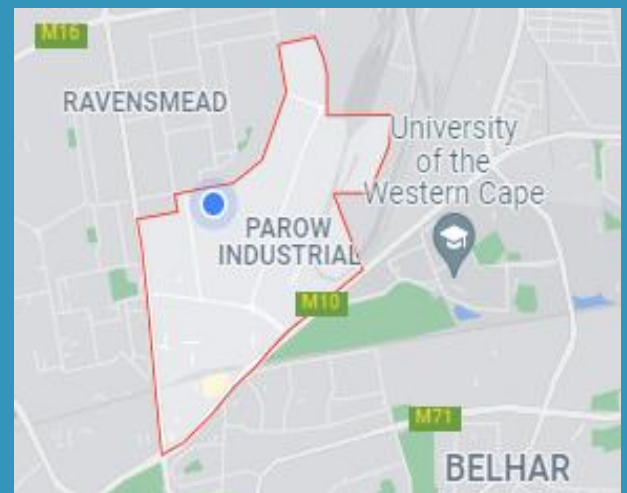

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR APRIL 2022: 9 INCIDENTS

4 April 2022: 03:51 – Illegal Trespassing: Assegaai Road: Suspects spotted entering premises. Owner and SAPS alerted but nobody found on premises. It is assumed the suspects exited the premises from the back to Junction Road.

13 April 2022: 09:57- Robbery of cellphone : Radnor Road (arrest) : Person robbed of cellphone through open car window whilst standing off at the red Radnor road robots cnr Radnor and De La Rey roads, by suspects who immediately ran to Uitsig thereafter. SAPS notified. Suspect arrested later after undermentioned incident.

13 April 2022: 12:25 – Attempted theft out of motor vehicle : Radnor Road (arrest) : Suspects monitored on camera acting suspiciously by a vehicle . Responders dispatched and found vehicle keys in suspects possession. Owner of vehicle alerted who confirmed that the keys open his vehicle. 2 x suspects arrested and handed over to SAPS. One suspect allegedly from the cellphone theft of the morning.

14 April 2022: 13:43 – Possession of suspected stolen goods : Trans Oranje road (arrest) : Responders searched males pushing a trolley and found suspected stolen copper cables. Suspects arrested and handed over to SAPS.

21 April 2022: 16:36 – Theft of bicycle: Stellenberg road : 1 x suspect stole a bicycle from a premises in Stellenberg road and left the area via Radnor Road. CID responders alerted but failed to apprehend the suspect. Footage handed over to SAPS for possible identification of the suspect and follow up.

22 April 2022: 15:14 – Possession of suspected stolen goods: Spin street (arrest) : CID responder saw a person on way to attempt to sell suspected stolen goods as scrap metal. Items positively identified by owner. suspect arrested and handed over to SAPS.

24 April 2022: 07:26 – Possession of suspected stolen goods: Tekstiel street (arrest - no case opened by owner) : 1 x suspect trolley searched and various items found which the responder then followed up as belonging to a truck driver parked in Tekstiel street. Owner did not want to open a case.

26 April 2022: 21:42 – Attempted theft : Trans Oranje road (arrest) : Suspect spotted on camera trying to cut cables from a trailer parked in the road. CID unable to respond due to both service providers vehicles being mechanical. SAPS and owner contacted. Person caught, cables retrieved. Owner decided not to open a case and suspect was let go.

29 April 2022: 01:22 – Attempted theft of COCT infrastructure: Trans Karoo street : Suspects spotted on camera pushing a trolley in Radnor road. Whilst monitoring them they attempted to steal a stop sign pole on the corner of Radnor and Trans Karoo street. SAPS alerted but suspects left the area via Robert Sobukwe robots without the sign pole.
