It has been a busy time and we are glad to be able to report on the following:

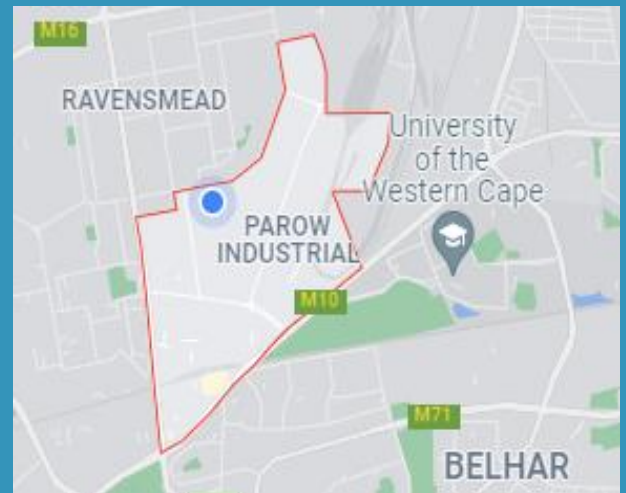
Resurfacing of Stoker Road took place in last week of February 2022.

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR FEBRUARY 2022: 12 INCIDENTS

3 Feb: 12:08 – CID responder checked trolley and found stolen COCT infrastructure. **Suspect arrested.**

3 Feb: 20:30 – Hijacking in Trans Karoo Road. CID informed after the fact.

7 Feb: 04:52 – person robbed of bag and cellphone in Stellenberg Road on way to work.

7 Feb: 09:54 – Wallet stolen out of open truck window in Spin Str, whilst driver was at back of truck.

9 Feb: 09:05 – Controller whilst monitoring saw persons stealing truck petrol caps in Spin Street. Responders dispatched . **Suspect arrested** and handed over to Ravensmead SAPS.

11 Feb: 20:55 – Truck driver robbed of his keys from ignition whilst standing off at garage to refuel. CID only informed after the fact.

15 Feb: 10:19 – Business owner informed of person walking with COCT infrastructure. CID responder followed up. **Suspect arrested** and handed over to Ravensmead SAPS.

15 Feb: 15:40 – Person robbed of cellphone through open window of vehicle standing at red robot on corner of Radnor and De La Rey roads. Person immediately ran into Uitsig thereafter.

17 Feb: 11:15 – Controller spotted person trying to take the name off a municipal bin belonging to business in Stellenberg Road. Responders dispatched and after confirming with nearby business the **Suspect arrested** and handed over to Ravensmead SAPS.

18 Feb: 00:28 – vandalism (4 taps stolen) in Radnor road. Person seen fleeing into Uitsig and on investigation found water running from premises.

18 Feb: 08:05 – Persons monitored on camera, searched and stolen goods found in their possession from a business in Assegai Road. **Suspects arrested.**

Loose lying bollards :

All the loose lying bollards which were reported were repaired by COCT.

Marking of Bins :

It is happening more and more often that business owners are losing their bins with refuse removal day on a Thursday. Kindly mark all your bins with paint or a permanent substance – that way our responders can react when they see a bin in the street that should be at a different premises.

Unsecured premises with lockup:

We attended to 3 incidents in January and 5 in February, where we had to call business owners after hours to come out and lock up properly, in most cases where there were open gates, in order to deter opportunistic crime.



Landscaping:

Junction traffic circle is currently in the process of being landscaped. The section along the wall in Industria Ring Road will also be done in March 2022.

Kittens looking for a forever home:

On 2022-03-08 these 4 adorable kittens (with eyes still closed) were found discarded with rubbish by a CID responder. The CID office took on the job of fostering these kittens until they are old enough to be placed.

Kindly contact the CID office should you be willing to take one of the kittens and give it a loving, forever home.
