The CID has also taken up the litter along De La Rey road, open erf next to Nebo primary and in Denton street with COCT solid waste Law enforcement, even though it is not part of the CID area but we feel it impacts on the image of the area.

The CID is currently busy with a Request for Proposal process to replace our current public safety service provider. More information will be provided in the April newsletter.

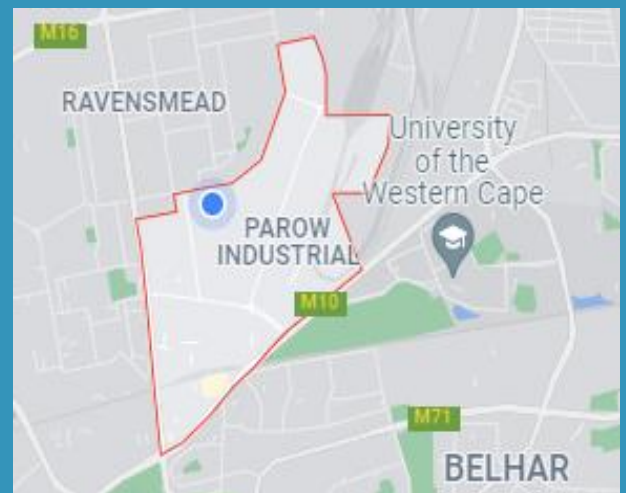
Councillor Jackie Visser has been appointed for our area as board observer and attended her first board meeting on 29 March 2022. We are looking forward to a good working relationship.

## CRIME INCIDENTS FOR MARCH 2022: 11 INCIDENTS

1 Mar @ 16:20 – Theft in Assegaai Road where copper pipes were stolen. Client did not make a case. Suspect released.

3 Mar @ 02:53 – Theft in Tekstiel Road where truck cables were stolen. **Positive arrest by the CID & cables returned.**

8 Mar @ 06:12 – Possession of suspected stolen goods in Assegaai Road. Cables were found on the suspect and handed over to SAPS with suspect. **Positive arrest by the CID & a criminal case was opened.**

12 Mar @ 09:38 – Possession of suspected stolen goods in Stoker Road. **Suspect was arrested by the CID with spanners & a steel hook**, but suspect escaped by kicking out the back window of the vehicle and disappeared into the bushes.

13 Mar @ 22:10 – Attempted Break-In. Two suspects attempted to break-in at a premises from the back of Industria Ring Road, but jumped back over the wall and ran away when they saw Security and the Responders.

16 Mar @ 01:38 – Attempted Break-In. Again two suspects tried to break-in at above premises by standing on each others shoulders, trying to climb over the fence at the premises. They ran away and climbed in a waiting vehicle when the CID Responders arrived.

20 Mar @ 15:07 – Possession of suspected stolen goods in Stoker Road. **Suspect was arrested by the CID with more spanners & steel hooks.** Suspect was transported to the Police Station and handed over.

20 Mar @ 21:58 – Alleged Attempted murder in Industria Road. A suspect tried to break into a premises but when spotted by the on-site security officer, shots were fired at him & he was hit on the head with the back of a gun, before the suspects ran away. SAPS and the CID Responders arrived to investigate and offer help.

21 Mar @ 16:25 – Possession of suspected stolen goods in Radnor Road. **Suspect was arrested by the CID with plugs & cables.** Suspect was transported to the Police Station and was handed over with the stolen goods.

28 Mar @ 19:22 – Attempted Break-In at Assegaai Road. Suspects were spotted trying to break-in. CID Responders managed to arrest one suspect and two ran away, who they attempted to apprehend without success. **One suspect arrested and handed over to SAPS.**

31 Mar @ 01:49 – Attempted Break-In at Industria Ring Road. Suspects attempted to break-in again at the back of the premises but ran away when the CID Responders arrived.

### Junction Circle Makeover

For almost 20 years Junction Circle in Junction/Radnor Road was covered with dead grass and loose sand that was an eye-sore. The Board of Directors recently approved landscaping which was finalized in March 2022.

Because there is no water on the circle, it was decided to go with the big Gabion rocks which requires no maintenance. In our financial years the COCT has indicated they will provide a few hardy shrubs for placement where the rock piles are currently on the outer rim. This is our first step in making this focal point on entering the area more aesthetically pleasing for your customers.



## KITTENS HAVE FOUND THEIR FOREVER HOMES

In our previous newsletter it was mentioned that the CID responders found four baby kittens that were thrown away in a black bag with rubbish in Spin Street on 8 March 2022. They were only a day old and have been bottle fed until now and went home each evening and weekend with the CID assistant which is a big commitment she made. The kittens are now eating on their own since yesterday and will go to their forever homes in a week or two.

Three persons from within the CID building have each adopted one, and one will go to a person outside the "CID family".
