Dear Business Owners,

Byers commenced duties as the CID's new service provider on 1 May 2022. The cleaners were each provided with their own trolley and are now easily identifiable in the area.



Theft of truck cables in and around Spin Street and opportunistic targeting of vehicles parked in Spin street is now on the rise. All persons parking in this area are cautioned to ensure no valuables are visible and that all doors and windows are locked.

Truck drivers are to be vigilant and ensure all cables are secured.

After the rains on 6 May 2022 the CID reported 13 potholes which have since been repaired throughout the area.

The CID is liaising with the COCT with regards to all the reinstatements to be done in the area.

COCT has indicated that the resurfacing of the last piece of Industria Ring Road between Assegai Road and Stellenberg Road will commence July/August 2022.

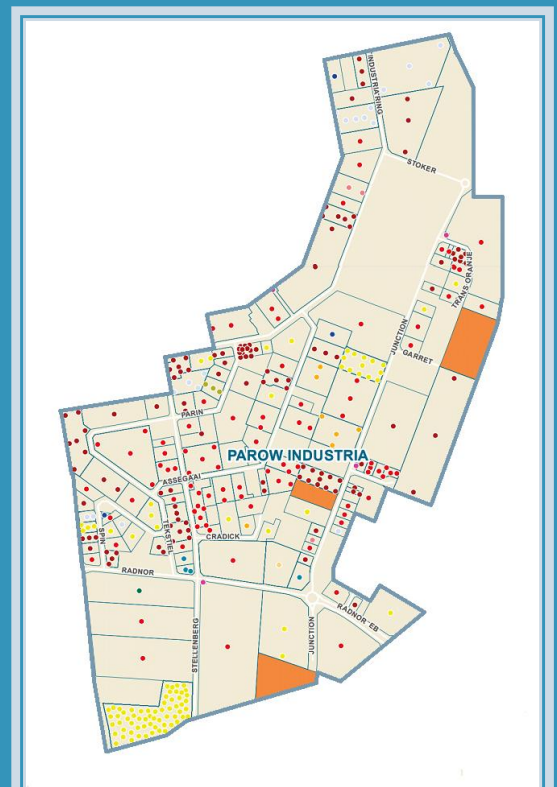
The CID has also requested that the uneven "crinkle cut" effect on the road surface around Junction circle be addressed, as part of this job, should funding allow.

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR MAY 2022: 16 INCIDENTS

1 May @ 18:45 – Possession of suspected stolen goods (metro rail steel) in Trans Oranje Road. Suspects ran away when spotting CID responders. Goods handed in at SAPS Ravensmead by CID responders.

1 May @ 21:37 – Attempted theft in Stellenberg Road. 2 x Males were unsuccessful in trying to steal truck cables as they ran away when the CID responder approached them.

2 May 2022 @ 18:26 – Possession of suspected stolen goods (metro rail steel) in Stoker road. Suspects arrested by CID responders and handed over to SAPS.

2 May 2022 @ 21:31 – Illegal trespassing at company in Spin Street. 2 suspicious males were monitored on camera and then searched by CID responders, when one suspect stabbed the CID responder in his arm. Suspects then ran away without taking anything.

3 May 2022 @ 08:50 - Theft of truck cable in Spin Street. A CID responder saw a male running towards Radnor robots and went to investigate in the direction he came from, and found a truck standing in Spin Streets cable had been stolen.

11 May 2022 @ 12:58 - Possession of suspected stolen goods (signage) in Stellenberg Road. CID responder searched a suspect and found signage belonging to a company in the area. The business did not want to make a case. SAPS informed the suspect is mentally disturbed. Suspect was let go and signage handed back to owner/company.

13 May 2022 @ 01:00 – Robbery at premises in Spin street where access was gained from De La Rey Road. On site Security guard was robbed, whereafter the suspects fled over the wall into De La Rey road again.

13 May 2022 @ 21:36 – Theft of vehicle battery from vehicle standing in spin Street for extended period, spotted on camera by CID control room, but by time CID responder arrived (within a minute), the suspects had already fled over the robots into Uitsig.

16 May 2022 @ 18:49 – Attempted robbery of cellphone corner of Radnor and Spin Street. CID control room monitored suspect attempting to grab a phone out of the hand of person speaking on it, but was unsuccessful. They immediately ran out of the area into Uitsig after the attempt.

17 May 2022 @ 13:03 – Attempted theft of truck cable in Spin Street. CID control room spotted person climbing on back of a truck in Spin Street. When CID responders approached the person ran away, without stealing anything.

19 May 2022 @ 00:32 – Theft of truck cable in Stellenberg Road. Persons spotted running towards Belhar railway station. CID responders apprehended one male whilst the other got away. SAPS released the suspect due to him being underage.

19 May 2022 @ 14:37 – Possession of suspected stolen good (metro rail steel) at Stoker circle. Suspect arrested by CID responders and handed over to SAPS.

21 May 2022 @ 21:15 – Attempted break in at premises in Industria Ring Road. Access gained from back of premises in Aandblom street by climbing over the wall. Nothing taken as the on site security scared them off.

27 May 2022 @ 02:08 – Alleged theft of ATM cable cnr of Radnor and Spin Street. Suspect monitored on CID camera attempting to pull out the ATM electrical wire. CID responder dispatched and arrested suspect. SAPS let suspect go as he was underage.

28 May 2022 @ 22:27 - Illegal trespassing and theft of jacket in Spin Street – Suspects monitored on CID camera jumping over the fence of a premises and coming out with a jacket. CID responder caught up with suspect and took him back to premises where the staff identified the jacket as belonging to one of them. Client did not want to open a case and just wanted the jacket back. SAPS indicated no case will be made as the client does not want to open one. SAPS escorted the suspect out of the area.

31 May 2022 @ 06:10 – Possession of suspected stolen goods in Spin Street – Suspect monitored on CID camera carrying two black bags. CID responder dispatched and searched suspect and found new jumper cables and other items. Suspect arrested and handed over with the goods to SAPS.

YEARLY EVACUATION DRILL

The CID arranged an evacuation drill with all relevant COCT departments on a yearly basis before Covid set in.

This was an opportunity to gauge our readiness, as well as that of Ravensmead SAPS, Fire and Ambulance services and other roleplayers, in the event of a major disaster where a big portion or all of the CID area could possibly need to be evacuated.

With the last exercise, a company in Garrett Street kindly volunteered to be used as the premises with the "emergency", and valuable lessons were learnt, as Disaster risk management really goes the extra mile to ensure that after the exercise the company is fully compliant with all aspects of OHS and also ready to face any emergency which may arise.

Ilona Petersen is now the new co-ordinator for Parow Industria area at COCT disaster risk management, and she has requested that I identify a volunteer company to have such an exercise later this year.

Kindly indicate if your company would be interested in such an initiative whereafter I will set up the necessary meeting with Ilona Petersen.
