Dear Business Owners,

Crime in the public space has been contained in July month with the CID recording 7 Incidents and SAPS another 6 which were not reported to the CID, all of which besides one occurred on private space and cannot be "policed" by the CID.

Known offenders profiling has been distributed to all Byers officers on patrol so as soon as they enter the area they are escorted out or if they are in the area for a legitamit reason are monitored until they leave the area.

The CID embarked on a turnaround strategy in Spin Street in July and the results are visible. The pressure will be kept up here in order to keep this street on the same standard as the others in the area.

The section between De La Rey Road and Fuel 1 garage remains a hotspot for cellphone theft opportunists. Keep doors locked and windows closed when standing at the robots and caution workers to not walk and talk on their phones as this creates the opportunity needed by the criminal elements.

The CID has taken a zero tolerance approach to persons coming into the area with animals that are not on leashes, after incidents where a suspect set his dog on the CID service provider responder when he was being arrested and a separate incident where a dog ran across the road after his owners and was hit by a vehicle whereafter he succumbed to his injuries and was just left by his owners for the CID to deal with the heartbreaking matter.

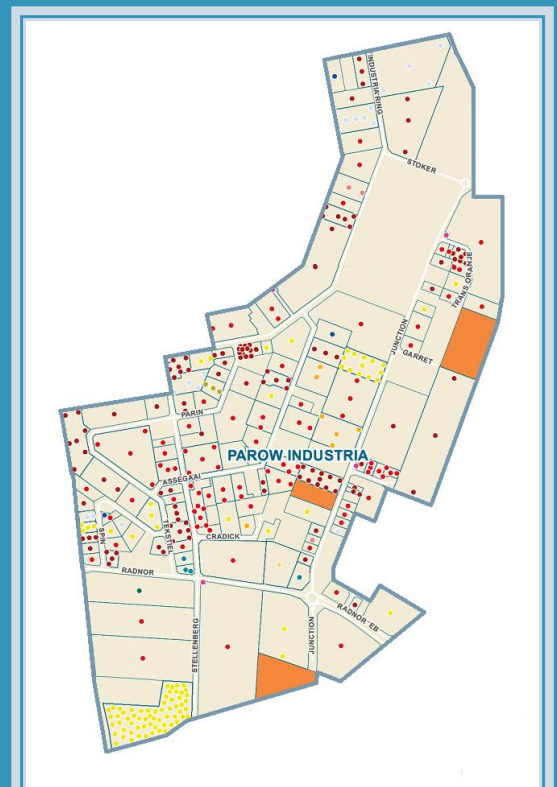
COCT has now resurfaced the last section of Industria Ring Road.

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR JULY 2022: 7 INCIDENTS

1 July 2022 @ approximately 08:50 : Attempted theft of Toolbox in Radnor Road. Toolbox retrieved by owner. Suspect let go by responders on a warning as owner left immediately after retrieving his toolbox.

16 July 2022 @ approximately 11:58 : Attempted break in at premises in Koets street. 2 males attempted to jump over the boundary fence but scared off by the on site security who called the CID responders. The males had already crossed into Robert Sobukwe robots at that stage. SAPS was contacted and a clothing description given.

18 July 2022@ approximately 18:30: Attempted robbery in Industria Ring Road: **Arrest by CID responders.** Whilst on patrol CID responders were informed by a male of others who attempted to rob him. CID responders found males and arrested them. SAPS called to site. Victim did not want to make a case. SAPS left the area with the two suspects.

19 July 2022@ approximately 11:51 : Attempted robbery in Stellenberg Road: **Arrest by CID responders.** CID responders arrested a male running away from a vehicle following him. Vehicle driver confirmed 2 x males tried to rob their cellphones. CID footpatrollers caught up with the second suspect. Both suspects handed over to SAPS who were called to the scene. The victim did not open a case as the phones were not stolen.

22 July 2022@ approximately 14:31 : Theft of toolbox in Spin Street. **Arrest by CID responders.**

CID footpatroller reported a male taking a toolbox from a truck in Spin Street and was walking towards Radnor Road. The CID patroller in that section arrested the male whilst he tried to stab him and his dog attempted to bite the responder. SAPS was called. The victim did not want to open a case as the toolbox was retrieved. The suspect was given a warning.

22 July 2022 @ approximately 19:18 : Illegal trespassing at premises in Industria Ring Road: **Arrest by CID responders.**

CID controlroom spotted a male gaining access to a premises. CID responders were dispatched and arrested the suspect. The suspect was taken to Ravensmead SAPS . Case docket opened by business owner.

25 July 2022 @ approximately 23:00 : Illegal trespassing and MITP in Spin Street. Suspects gained access to a premises in Spin street by breaking through a section of the vibracrete wall from De La Rey Road, in order to gain access to the premises next door. Suspects were unsuccessful.

SAPS informed the CID of an alleged Theft of Motorvehicle case opened which allegedly occurred on 2022-07-22 between 07:45 and 13:00 in Radnor Road. The CID was not able to get any details at time of sending out this newsletter.

SAPS & CID JOINT STOP AND SEARCH OPERATION

SAPS and the CID appointed service provider had a joint stop and search operation in the area on 2022-07-28 as arranged by the CID. Unfortunately we had to stop the operation after an hour due to the quietness of the area.
