Dear Business Owners,

Herewith find our crime for the month of October as well as our Proactive services conducted.

Please be aware of your surroundings at the Radnor/De La Rey Road robots, and keep your doors locked. The CID is now chasing the persons who beg at the robots away, as there have been numerous attempts to steal from stationary vehicles. As a result, suspects are now targeting vehicles outside our boundary at the other stops of this intersection and last week there were incidents of cellphone theft due to unlocked doors and open windows.

As you will have noted there have been numerous land surveyors throughout the area of late. They are busy determining where and how deep all the current underground pipes are, for the planning of the upgrading of the stormwater system downstream of Parow Industria to the Elsieskraal channel. When this project is completed the flooding in the area when we have heavy rain should be alleviated.

The PIID AGM is taking place on 29 November 2022. Should you wish to register as a CID member kindly ensure you do so before 21 November 2022. Only registered CID members may vote at an AGM. You can view the website for any further information in this regard or contact us on the numbers hereunder.

Attached find media release of COCT with regards to prepaid meters, which could not only be applicable to your business here in the area but also your residence should you have a prepaid meter.

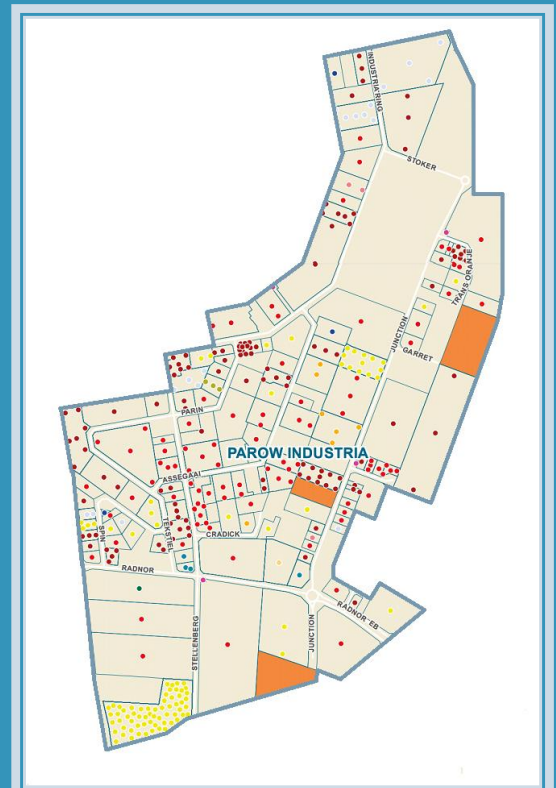

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR OCTOBER 2022: 6 INCIDENTS - other 2 outside the CID geographical area

01 October 2022 @ approximately 22:41: Inquest: Tekstiel Street

The CID Responders spotted a male lying in Tekstiel Street who appeared injured. The control room contacted the Ambulance and Ravensmead SAPS to report the incident. The male was taken away by ambulance to hospital. It was later ascertained that the male had passed away. During playback of the CID's camera system and further investigation, it was found that the male attempted to steal truck cables, unknown to the driver, whilst the truck was moving, and allegedly fell off, when the truck entered Tekstiel Street. All relevant footage was handed over to Ravensmead SAPS for further investigation.

07 October 2022 @ approximately 10:06: Prevention of theft from a vehicle in Radnor Road

Whilst the CID controllers were monitoring the cameras, they spotted a known suspect and his friends in the area, on the corner of Radnor and Spin Street. The CID Foot Patrollers and Responders were immediately alerted to monitor them. They noticed the known suspect walking towards a parked truck with an open window. The suspect not knowing he is being watched, suddenly jumped onto the truck to peek inside, when the CID Foot Patroller and Responder acted, chasing him and his friends out of the area towards Uitsig.

10 October 2022 @ approximately 12:17: Theft from the back of a truck by Radnor Robots.

The control room spotted the same known suspect and his friends early morning in the area and started monitoring them again. Later whilst monitoring them all the time, they saw them crossing Radnor Road seemingly heading out of the area toward Uitsig via Radnor/De La Rey Robots. Suddenly whilst crossing the road, the suspect stopped at the back of a truck waiting at Radnor Robots which was red, when he quickly opened the door and grabbed a 24 pack Savannah's. As he tried to run towards Uitsig, the CID responder who was on the other side of the road and could not reach him due to traffic, shouted, alerting the truck driver whose passenger jumped out and caught up with the suspect. He managed to retrieve the stolen goods and the suspect disappeared into Uitsig.

11 October 2022 @ approximately 15:12: Possession of Suspected Stolen Goods in Spin Street. Arrest by CID Responders.

While driving in Spin Street, the CID Responders noticed a male with something suspicious in his trolley. When the Responder stopped to investigate, he recognized a piece of metal that he had noticed was stolen from the bus stop in Radnor Road with his area check earlier. The male was arrested and Ravensmead SAPS was contacted. The CID Responder took the suspect and stolen goods to Ravensmead SAPS as they did not have a vehicle available at the time.

21 October 2022 @ approximately 23:44: Attempted Break-In from the back of Spin Street. Outside our Geographical Area.

While the CID Responders were busy escorting a male out of the area, a security guard from one of the premises in Spin Street, approached the vehicle and informed them that someone tried to break through the vibracrete wall at the back by De La Rey Road. The CID control room contacted the owner to inform him, and he requested that the CID inform the security guard to cover the hole, as he will address it the next day. Ravensmead SAPS was also contacted and when they arrived, they assisted the guard to cover the hole as a temporary measure to prevent further access.

24 October 2022 @ approximately 12:24: Theft of cellphone in Radnor Road. Arrest by Ravensmead SAPS

The CID Office received a phone call from a client in Radnor Road regarding a theft of a cellphone out of a vehicle. The control room did a playback and noticed the known suspect of the cases of 7 and 10 October mentioned above, entering the area, walking past a truck, backtracking, and picking up a stone and then smashing the window of the truck which was parked on the pavement just before the Radnor/De La Rey robots. The suspect grabbed a cellphone which was in the cab and ran towards Uitsig. The CID Control room contacted Ravensmead SAPS immediately and the victim was convinced to go to Ravensmead Police Station to open a case. The CID service provider Operational Manager escorted the victim as he was too scared to drive on his own to Ravensmead SAPS with the broken window. Because this victim did the effort to open a case, and the CID was able to identify the suspect and provide the necessary footage, the suspect was finally arrested by Ravensmead SAPS and taken into custody.

25 October 2022 @ approximately 11:06: Attempted Break-In from the back of Spin Street. Outside our Geographical Area.

The control room received a call from a member of the public informing them of 2 x males trying to break in through the vibracrete wall at the back by De La Rey Road. The control room immediately tried to spot the males but as De La Rey Road is out of our geographical area, they were unable to spot anything on our camera system. The CID Responders were dispatched to inform the manager of the premises. The manager confirmed that there was a hole in the wall, and it will be repaired.

26 October 2022 @ approximately 10:51: Stolen vehicle in Spin Street.

While on area check, two workers approached the CID Supervisor, informing them that a vehicle had just been stolen in Spin Street. The control room did a playback to investigate the situation and found suspicious persons in the street where the vehicle was parked just before the CID camera turns away on its rotation. When the camera turns back (within a minute) the stolen vehicle is already being driven away down Spin Street. A case was made at Ravensmead Police Station and all available footage was downloaded and handed over to SAPS for further investigation.
