And it is December once again 😊....

Sadly, we said goodbye to Mr Ausef Raad who was one of the founder members of Parow Industria CID 21 years ago, and who has been the Chairman of the Board for the past couple of years, at the AGM which took place on 29 November 2022. Mr Raad is now going to go on well deserved retirement and we wish him all the best.

The CID office sent out the shutdown period information request per email this morning – please take the time to respond as this information assists us in giving you the best possible service during the shutdown period. Crime is currently at an all-time low, and we wish to keep it that way.

14 November 2022 was the first Monday in the past 5 years where there were no faulty streetlights for the CID to report. A comprehensive streetlight check is done street for street every Sunday night and reported to COCT, as well as ad hoc cases as and when they occur.

Please be patient with water reinstatements required in the area. The COCT repairs all pipe bursts when reported but unfortunately the reinstatement (retarring) is put on a priority list for another contractor. The CID is aware of all the water reinstatements required and has it on a brought forward system for regular enquiries. I will also raise this fact of how long this takes at a CID Forum to be held 13 December.

Please be aware of a new tendency where persons walk into open workshops and make like they belong there to scout for items to steal. Where your workshop is accessible from the street, ensure your workers are vigilant and report any persons who should not be on site to the CID control room (021 932 4800) so that we can assist.

The CID has limited stickers available with the CID contact numbers at our office should anyone wish to collect – this sticker can be pasted onto the back of a cell phone for easy access in the event of an emergency.

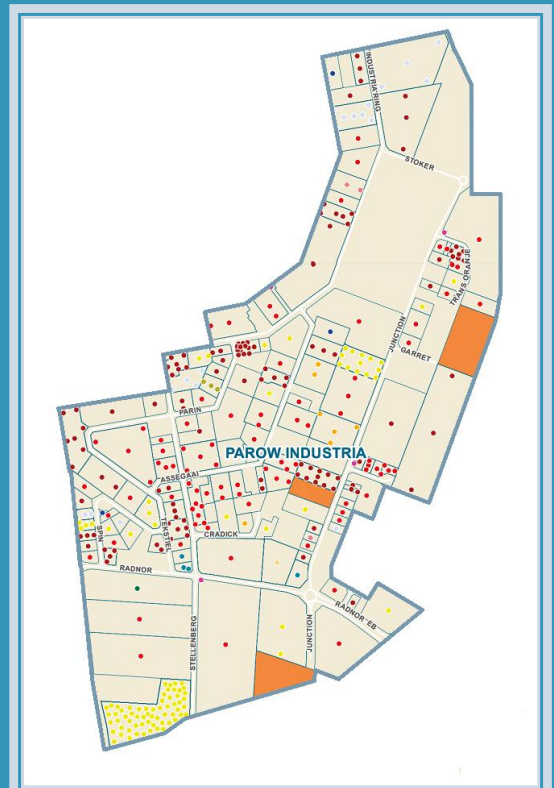

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR NOVEMBER 2022: 1 INCIDENT

17 November 2022 @ approximately 15:55: Possession of Suspected Stolen Goods by Stoker Circle (Arrest by CID)

While monitoring, the CID control room spotted a male emerging from the bushes by Stoker Circle with a bunch of branches and a trolley. The controllers then spotted 3 x security guards starting to chase the male down Junction Road. CID Responders were dispatched who caught the male in Junction Road, where he was placed in the back of the vehicle. The security guards who had been chasing him caught up and informed the CID that the suspect was in possession of copper. The CID Responder took the suspect and stolen goods to Ravensmead SAPS, where a case was opened.
