Dear Business Owners,

Here we are in the middle of winter again and having to contend with potholes. Please be assured that the CID is aware of each pothole and makes a concerted effort to have it addressed as soon as possible. All potholes were escalated 9 June 2023. We do however also need to be cognizant of the fact that the COCT has a 30-day lead time in which to repair potholes and requires good weather in which to do so. With all the rain of late it has given rise to a less than ideal situation due to the resultant backlog. We however give our commitment that we are doing everything to get this attended as soon as possible by COCT.

On 2023-06-12 the CID reported 72 faulty streetlights which were all repaired on 2023-06-13 despite COCT warning of high volumes of faults logged due to flooding and that the 14-day lead time could now be longer. Faulty streetlights are reported every Monday morning and ad hoc if required.

The CID office has been requested to facilitate a session where SAPS can advise on safety techniques/measures on how to keep yourself and your possessions/property as safe as possible. Before arranging such, it would be appreciated if you can give an indication of how many persons would be interested in attending such a session (approximately 1 hour) so that a suitable venue in the CID area can be sourced. Kindly just provide your company name and nr of persons by no later than 2023-07-21 whereafter we will revert on whether there is sufficient interest to go ahead.

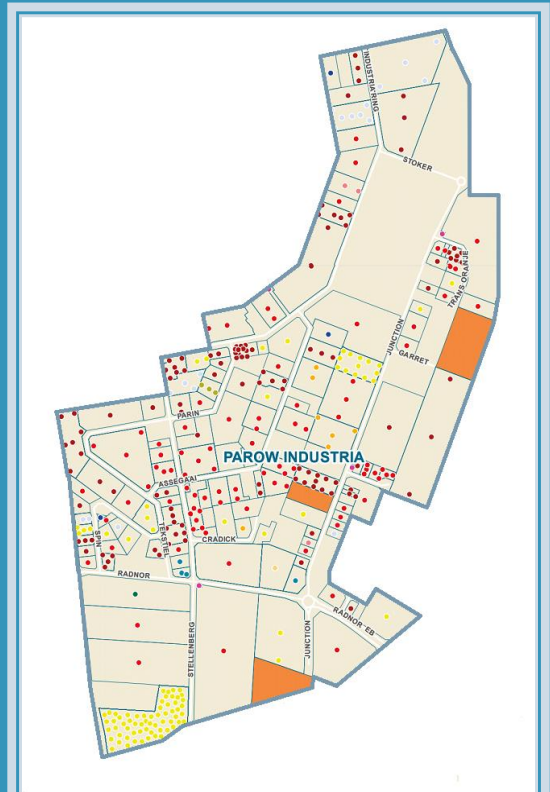
The CID's AGM date has been set as 23 November 2023. More information will follow closer to the time.

CRIME INCIDENTS FOR MAY 2023: 10 INCIDENTS

01 June 2023 @ approximately 02:23: Possession of Suspected Stolen Truck Cables: Junction Road (Arrest by CID Responders)

The CID control room spotted 2 x males with a backpack coming out of the bushes and heading up towards Junction Road. Both CID Response vehicles were dispatched, and they caught up with them. After searching their backpack, the Responders found truck cables. The one Responder left to investigate where the cables were possibly stolen and found a truck parked in Trans Karoo Road without cables. The Responder woke the truck driver who confirmed the missing cables and the second Responder arrested both males. The truck driver then confirmed that the stolen cables were indeed his. The CID control room contacted SAPS who arrived to fetch the suspects. The truck driver then indicated he will not be opening a case.

02 June 2023 @ approximately 17:35: Hijacking/Kidnapping: Stoker Road (8 arrests made by SAPS task team)

Due to the sensitive nature of this incident, ongoing investigation, and out of respect for the family no details will be provided. The CID provided available camera footage to the HAWKS. The victim was thankfully reunited with her family and SAPS subsequently made 8 arrests.

07 June 2023 @ approximately 12:37: Assault GBH: Stabbing of CID Foot Patroller: Cnr of Radnor and Spin Street.

Whilst patrolling, a CID Foot Patroller noticed a male walking quite closely behind him. When the male noticed he has been caught out he attempted to attack the foot patroller. The Foot Patroller used his pepper spray on the suspect and the suspect started running towards Radnor Road robots to cross into Uitsig. A second Foot Patroller came running to provide support. While the foot patrollers were chasing the suspect, another male came running from behind, and stabbed one of the Foot Patrollers in his back with a knife, before running out of the area towards Uitsig after the 1st suspect. As the stabbing incident made both foot patrollers lose momentum the suspects were able to escape over the robots. The Foot Patroller sustained minor injury which was treated.

09 June 2023 @ approximately 18:44: Attempted Murder/Shooting: Radnor/Robert Sobukwe Robots (Outside the CID's geographical area)

An alleged gang related shooting occurred between two vehicles just before Robert Sobukwe robots when coming down Radnor Road. The vehicles turned into Robert Sobukwe where the one vehicles occupant shot at the other before the other vehicles occupants allegedly returned fire. Footage of the vehicles registration numbers and descriptions were handed over to the SAPS Anti-Gang Unit. Nobody was killed.

16 June 2023 @ approximately 12:50: Illegal Trespassing: Assegaai Road

The control room received a call from a client requesting assistance from the CID, as he spotted 2 x males on his premises from his camera monitoring system. A CID Responder was immediately dispatched and on arrival found that the onsite security/alarm monitoring was already standing off at the premises. The client showed the footage on his phone to the CID Responder who confirmed that he identified the one suspect as a known offender in the area. On doing footage playback, the CID control room spotted the 2 x males inside the premises where they entered by bending the fence. When Fidelity Response arrived, the suspects immediately left the premises heading in the opposite direction, then left the area towards MC Beukes Street.

16 June 2023 @ approximately 18:40: Illegal Trespassing: Assegaai Road (Arrest by ADT Response)

While monitoring, the control room spotted ADT Response, two employees and a CID Responder standing in Assegaai Road with 1 x male laying on the ground. The Responder confirmed that ADT Response caught the male who tried to break-in earlier that day and the two employees were there due to an alarm activation. The control room contacted Ravensmead SAPS who indicated that they had no vehicles available at that moment. The employees confirmed that they and ADT Response will take the suspect to the Police Station to open a case.

19 June 2023 @ approximately 09:10: Break-In: Denton Street (on border of CID's geographical area)

The control room received a call from a client, informing them about a break-in the previous evening, where multiple tools and equipment were stolen after the vibracrete wall was broken behind the substation to gain access to the premises. Footage was extracted and handed over to SAPS.

23 June 2023 @ approximately 17:04: Robbery of delivery Motorcycle: cnr Industria Ring Road and MCBeukes (on border of CID's geographical area)

The CID control room whilst monitoring spotted a delivery driver in Industria Ring Road close to the corner of MC Beukes what appeared to be in an altercation with 2 x males. A CID Responder was immediately dispatched, whilst the control room contacted SAPS. Upon arrival, the Responder confirmed that the 2 x males stole the delivery drivers' motorcycle and made a quick escape via MC Beukes Road. The control room re-contacted SAPS, but the victim informed he does not want to wait and will open a case later himself at Ravensmead SAPS.

23 June 2023 @ approximately 21:28: Illegal Trespassing: Back of a premises: De La Rey Road (Outside the CID's geographical area)

The control room spotted 1 x female and 2 x males at the back of a premises in De La Rey Road and noticed the 1 x male cutting the electric wires, climbing over the wall into the premises and then climbing back, before walking in De La Ry Road up towards the De La Rey/Radnor intersection robots with the female and other male. The CID Responders were immediately dispatched to the robots which is the border of

the CID geographical area. When the suspects saw the CID vehicle up ahead, they crossed the road and went into Uitsig. The Operational Manager and the Byers Armed Response Unit (not CID patrol vehicles) arrived at the back of the premises in De La Rey Road to investigate. They confirmed they did not spot anything else suspicious and patrolled the premises before leaving. The CID control room informed the client of the incident.

28 June 2023 @ approximately 03:05: Theft of truck cables: Stellenberg Road (Arrest by CID Responders)

While busy monitoring, the control room spotted a male walking down Stellenberg Road towards a parked truck. The male stole the truck cables and when he saw a Tazz coming down the road, he stopped the Tazz and got into the vehicle. During this time, the Responder was dispatched by the control room and caught up with the Tazz, stopping the vehicle to conduct a vehicle search. When the Responder found the truck cables under the seat, the suspect jumped out of the vehicle and started running. The CID responder caught the suspect in Radnor Road and detained him at the back of the CID patrol vehicle. The Responder returned to the truck and the Tazz where the other Responder was standing by while the control room contacted SAPS. The Responder reported that the person driving the Tazz informed him that he did not know the suspect and was only giving him a lift. The truck driver confirmed that the cables do belong to him and informed the Responder that he must leave soon. SAPS was re-contacted again and arrived shortly after to take the suspect into custody.
